DESCRIPTION OF BURIAL GROUND

MEETING HOUSE
LEVERETT, MASS. 01054

The Northerly corner of the Burial Ground can be located by proceeding ~~twenty feet~~ SOUTHWESTERLY along the extension of the Southeast foundation wall of the Meeting House to a point twenty feet from the Southerly corner of the Meeting House; then twenty feet SOUTHEASTERLY parallel to the Southwest wall of the Meeting House to an iron stake set flush with the ground surface and marked by a flat stone.

From the iron stake marking the Northerly corner of the Burial Ground, seventy feet SOUTHEASTERLY parallel to the Southwest wall of the Meeting House to the Easterly corner of the Burial Ground, marked by an iron stake set flush with the ground surface and marked by a flat stone; then one hundred fifty feet SOUTHWESTERLY parallel to the Southeast wall of the Meeting House to the Southerly corner of the Burial Ground, marked by an iron stake projecting above the ground surface among a pile of stones; then NORTHWESTERLY seventy feet parallel to the Southwest wall of the Meeting House to the Westerly corner of the Burial Ground, marked by an iron stake projecting above the ground surface among a pile of stones; then one hundred fifty feet NORTHEASTERLY parallel to the Southeast wall of the Meeting House to the Northerly corner of the Burial Ground.
